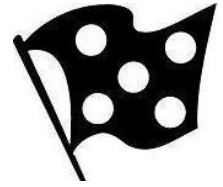

LAO News (From Ray)

While the OHV community made strides in 2010 the battle continues into 2011. Specifically there are two announcements that are of concern. I'll be watching these issues and bringing you news and instructions on how to get involved.

First, President Obama has issues an order giving the EPA authority to regulate carbon emissions. With this authority the EPA has the ability to ban OHVs under the guise of 'carbon reduction'. This is has the potential to impact the OHV community in a big way. I'll be watching and keeping you posted.

Also announced was the Wild Lands policy for the BLM. This order issued by Secretary of Interior Salazar gives the BLM authority to designate land as 'Lands with Wilderness Characteristics'. The BLM can now block OHV usage on lands under its management.

These are both serious national issues. As I learn more I'll keep you posted on how we can get involved and defend our rights to ride public land.
